SECTION 4) FIRST-AID MEASURES

Eye Contact:

Extinguishing Media:

Safe Handling:

Store indoors at temperatures below 120°F (49°C). Store in original containers. Avoid getting moisture into containers. Keep containers tightly closed.

SECTION 10) STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Reactivity:

Not normally reactive.

Chemical Stability:

Stable under recommended conditions. After prolonged storage, may crystallize.

Possibility of Hazardous Reactions:

Masses of ≥ 1 lb. (0.5 kg) plus aliphatic amine will cause irreversible polymerization with considerable heat build-up. Material will polymerize with sodium hydroxide.

Conditions to Avoid:

Avoid excessive heat.

Incompatible Materials:

Avoid contact with strong oxidizing agents, acids, alkalis, amines, mercaptans.

Hazardous Decomposition Products:

Uncontrolled exothermic reaction of epoxy resin releases carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, phenolics, and aldehydes.
